



JUNE FIN FACTS WITH SEA TURTLES









- There are 7 species of sea turtles; loggerhead, leatherback, olive ridley, hawksbill, flatback, green, and Kemp's ridley.
- The largest species, the leatherback, can grow up to 6 feet long and weigh over 1000 pounds!
- Many turtles can hold their breath for over 30 minutes. Green sea turtles can hold theirs for hours.
- Unlike turtles on the land, sea turtles cannot pull their heads and legs up into their protective shells.
- Sea turtles can live more than 150 years!
- Sea turtles can detect the Earth's magnetic field and use it as a compass.
- Female sea turtles lay 100-200
 eggs at a time in a hole on the
 beach and leave them there alone
 for two months.
- When baby sea turtles hatch they wait until nighttime and make their way into the ocean by themselves.



Directions:

Get an adult to help with the next steps of using the microwave and handling the hot candies

Microwave 30-45 seconds, or until the caramel is soft Place a pecan half onto each Rolo and press down to flatten Slide wax paper and pretzels onto the counter and allow to cool
