



- There are three main types of coral reefs: fringe reef, barrier reef, and atoll.
- Fringe reefs grow close to shore, while barrier reefs grow far from shore.
- Atolls are coral reefs that grow as a ring surrounding a lagoon of water.
- Some atolls grow so large that people live on them, like Maldives!
- Coral reefs are home to more than 4,000 species of fish!
- Coral reefs are alive. The living part of a coral reef is called coral polyps.
- More than 60% of the coral reefs in the United States are found throughout the Hawaiian Island chain.
- Even though they are under water, coral reefs need sunlight to grow.
- Coral reefs make the sea bed more stable.


Meet our friend Anna!

Guppy Goodies

Finding Dory Coral Reef Rock Candy

Ingredients: 1 cup water 3 cups granulated sugar Food coloring Candy flavoring Lollipop sticks Glasses Clothes pins An adult to help with boiling water and pouring hot sugar Patience to wait while your coral grows

Directions:

To each glass add one drop of food coloring and flavoring.

Dip the lollipop sticks into water where you would like the crystals to grow.

Set aside to dry.

Measure sugar into a bowl and set aside.

Add water to a large pot and bring to a boil. Add one cup of sugar at a time to the water. Stir until dissolved.

After all the sugar is added and fully dissolved. Pour into each glass and stir to combine the food coloring and flavoring.

Let sugar come to room temperature.

Submerge the lollipop sticks in the glass and secure them with clothes pins.

Wait for your coral reef to grow.

When it reaches your desired size, reef or atoll, enjoy!
