









- An octopus has three hearts.
- Octopuses have blue blood.
- There are around 300 species of octopus.
- Octopuses are invertebrates, meaning they have no skeleton.
- An octopus has a hard beak, like a bird's beak, that they use to break open crabs and other shellfish.
- The coconut octopus carry coconut shells on its head to help hide from predators swimming above them.
- The word octopus comes from the Greek word októpus, meaning "eight foot". Six of those limbs actually act more like arms while the other two are used more like feet, helping the octopus walk along the seabed.

Octopus and Seaweed

Ingredients: 4 hot dogs 1 package beef ramen noodles 5 drops green food coloring, optional Water Prepared mustard An adult to help with the cutting and cooking tasks Directions:

- In a saucepan, bring 1 ½ cups of water to a boil. Add noodles and the seasoning packet and cook until the noodles are tender.
- Cut each hot dog into eight strips, leaving about 2 inches uncut.
- In another saucepan bring more water to a boil. Place hotdogs in the boiling water and cook until heated through.
- Add food coloring to noodles.
- Serve noodles on plates and top with a hot dog octopus. Add mustard to make the eyes and mouth.
