







- Narwhals belong to the whale family.
- The "horn" on a narwhal is called a tusk.
- The tusk is one of two teeth narwhals have on their upper jaw that grow outward at adulthood.
- Not all narwhals have tusks. It is mostly males who have them. But some females do too.
- The narwhal tusk is like an inside out tooth. It is soft on the outside and very sensitive.
- Some narwhals have grown a double tusk.
- Narwhals live in very cold, icy water. They are seen a lot in northern Russia, Greenland, and northeastern Canada. They have even been seen near Point Barrow, Alaska.
- Narwhals change colors as they grow up- babies are blue-gray, young narwhals are blue-black, adults are gray, and old narwhals are white.








