

# FEBRUARY FIN FACTS WITH WHALES!












- There are two types of whales- baleen and toothed. The main difference is their mouths and the way they feed. Baleen whales have baleen plates in their mouths that they pull and sift small prey through. Toothed whales have teeth and actively hunt for fish and other sea creatures to eat.
- All whales breath through blowholes (nostrils) on the tops of their heads. Baleen whales have two blowholes, while toothed whales have one. They sleep at the top of the water with their blowholes just above the surface.
- There are 14 species of baleen whale, including bowhead, humpback, grey, minke, and blue. There are 76 species of toothed whale, including beluga, narwhal, orca, pilot, dolphin, and porpoise.
- Whales are mammals. They breath air, feed their babies milk, and give live birth instead of laying eggs.
- In the cooler months whales migrate, moving to warmer waters.
- Whales live in large groups called pods.
- Whales can eat up to two tons (4,000 pounds) of food a day!
- All whales are noisy. They make all sorts of sounds and noises to communicate. They are the loudest animals in the world.
- The blue whale is the largest animal in existence. They can reach over 100 feet longthat is 3 school busses!

#### Krilled Cheese Sandwiches

1 6 ounce can tuna, drained

'4 c plain Greek yogurt

4 slices bread

1 T olive oil

4 slices tomato

8 slices pickle

2 slices cheddar cheese

An adult to help with the oven

- Preheat oven to 400 degrees F
- In a small bowl, combine the tuna and Greek yogurt. Mix until well combined
- Brush one side of the bread slices with olive oil
- Place two slices of bread oil side down on a sheet pan
- Spread the tuna mixture evenly across the two slices of bread
- Top both slices of bread with tomato, pickle, and cheese slices
- Place remaining two slices of bread on top of the two sandwiches, oil side up
- Place in oven for 6-8 minutes, until the cheese is melted and the bread is golden brown
