### MAY FIN FACTS WITH

## SHOREBIRDS AND SEABIRDS!









- Alaska has recorded 77 species of shorebirds. That is 1/3 of the total species in the world.
- The terms shorebird and seabird have similar meanings and are often used interchangeably. Shorebirds are birds that are found near the edge of bodies of water. Seabirds are birds that spend most of their time in or flying over coastal waters.
- A puffin's beak changes color throughout the year. It is a dull gray in the winter, then changes to bright orange in the spring.
- The Sea of Cortez, in California, is home to the smallest seabird in the world. The Least Storm Petrel weighs in at only 1 ounce.
- The largest seabird in the world is the Wandering Albatross. It can get as tall as 4 ½' and can have a wingspan measuring a whopping 11'!
- Seabirds have their own natural built-in sunglasses. Their eyes contain special droplets of red oil in the retinas, which act as a sun filter to help with the glare from the sea and sand.
- Flamingoes get their coloring from the microscopic water plants and animals they eat.
- The Alaska SeaLife Center in Seward cares for about 13 different species of birds; approximately 150 individual birds.



#### **Pirate Munch Party Mix**

2 c square pretzels (treasure maps)

1/4 t sea salt


Marvelous Mermaid Munchies Pirate's Treasure (optional) (more treasure!)
