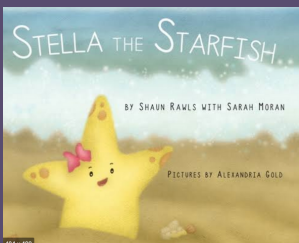

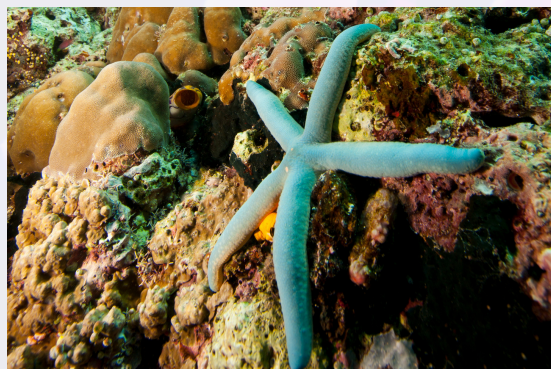

SEA STARS!



- Starfish are not fish at all. Since they do not have gills, scales, or fins like fish do, scientists prefer to call them sea stars.
- Sea stars are closely related to sand dollars and sea urchins.
- There are around 2000 different species of sea stars.
- The primary diet of sea stars are corals and clams.
- Sea stars can have anywhere from 5 to 40 arms!
- If a sea star loses an arm, it can regenerate it (grow a new one). In some cases, the arm that has been lost can grow a whole new star!
- Sea stars have an eye at the end of each arm. That means the sun star, who has the most arms, has 40 eyes.
- When eating, the sea star's stomach comes out of its mouth to digest the food and then reenters its body when it is done.
- Sea stars have no brain and no blood. They use filtered sea water to pump nutrients through its nervous system.

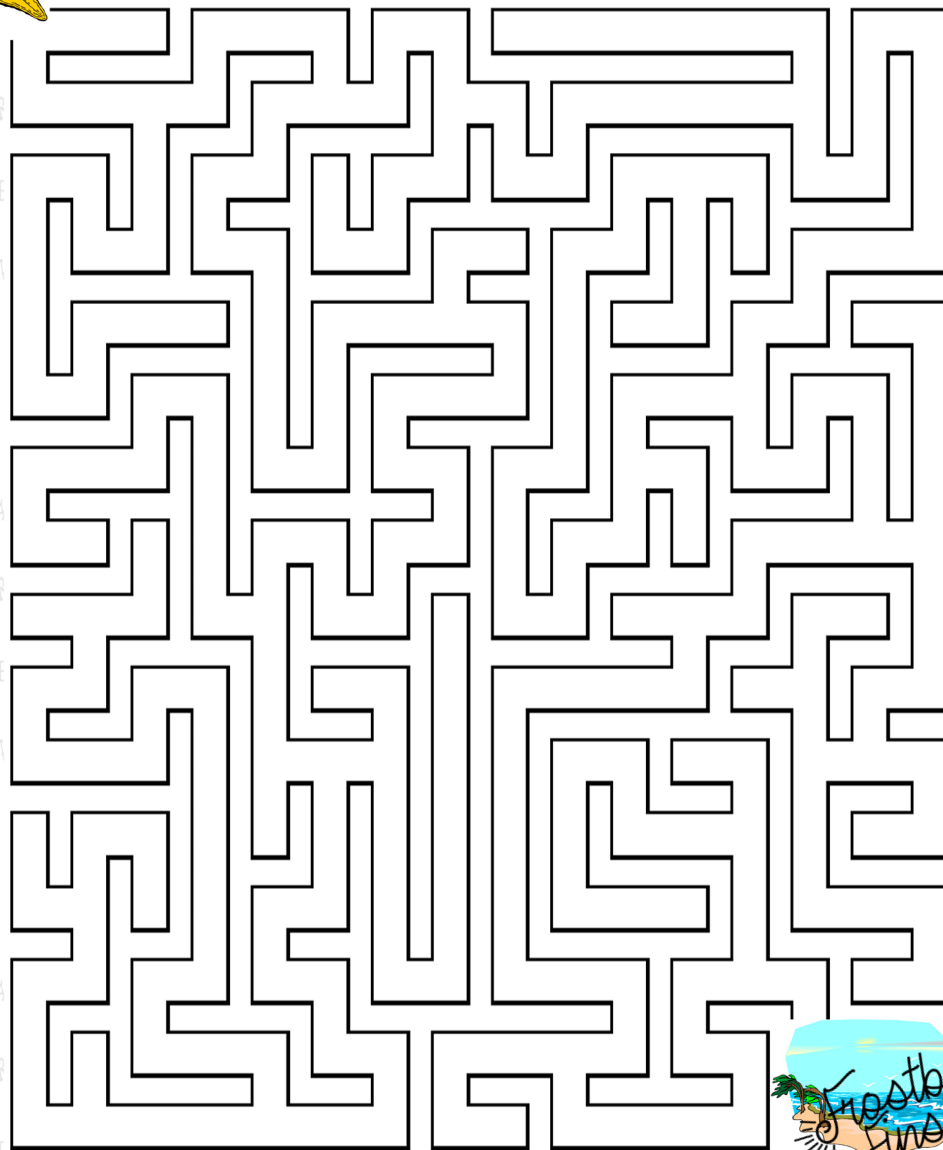
