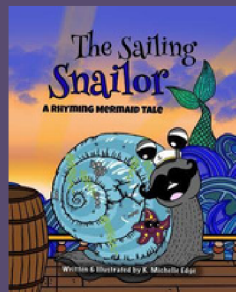
Enjoy the newsletter - and we'll see you at the Fair! Be sure to follow us on Facebook and Instagram for other upcoming dates as well.

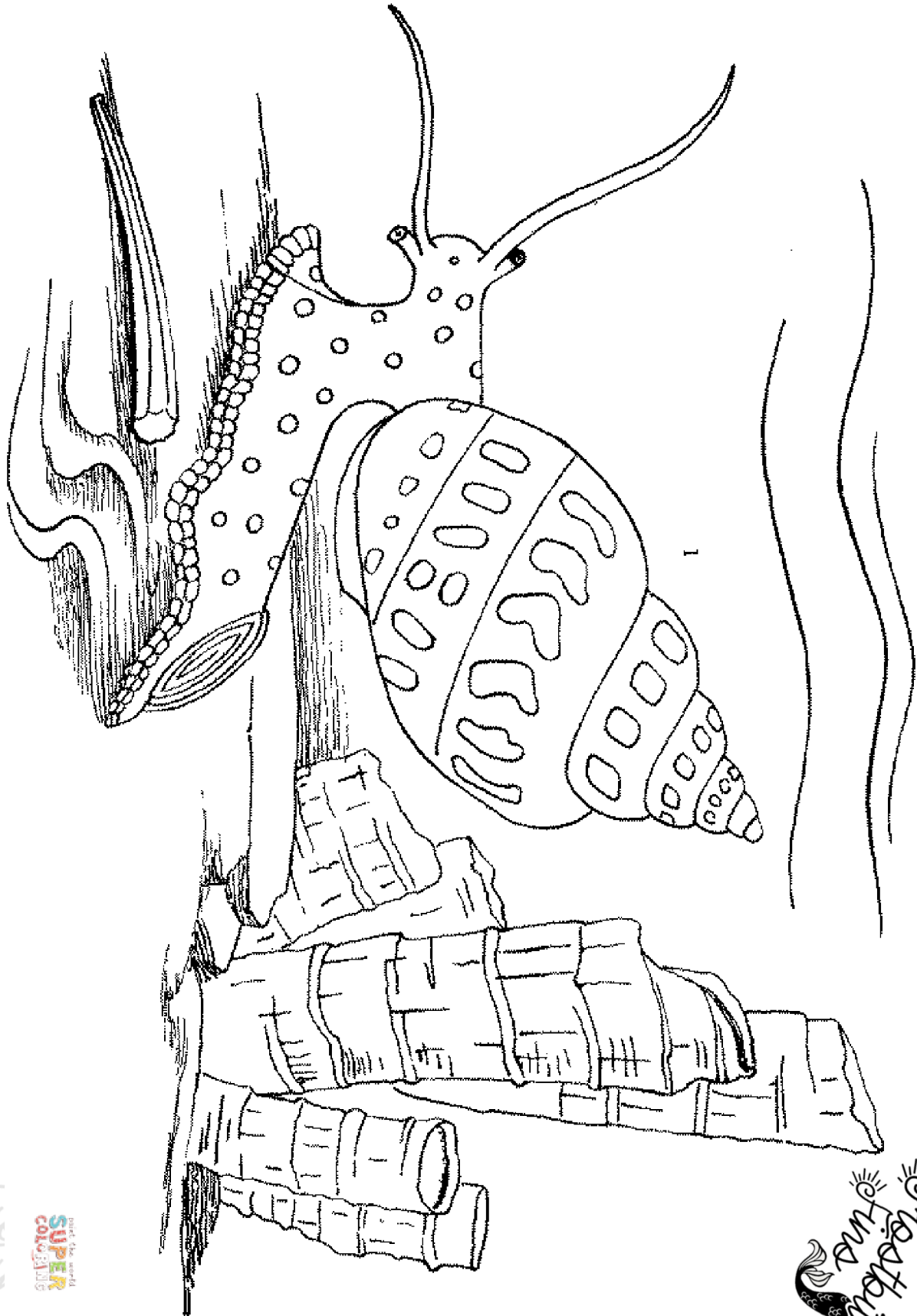

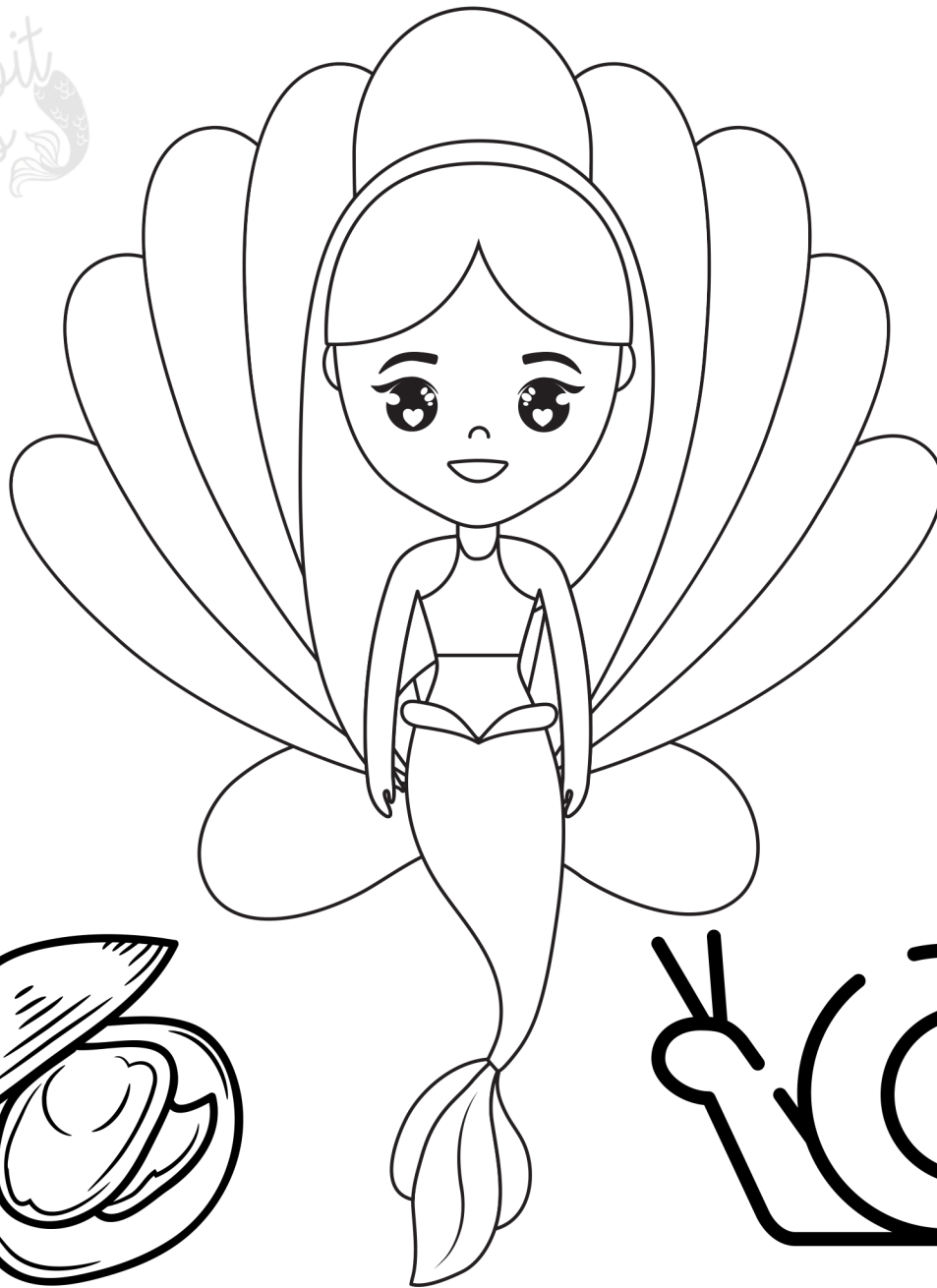


MOLLUSKS!



- Mollusks are invertebrates, meaning that they have no backbone.
- There are more than 100,000 species of mollusk, including octopuses, oysters, snails, clams, and squid!
- Mollusks have a soft body, with a covering called the mantle. In most kinds of mollusks, the mantle makes a shell. Other kinds of mollusks, like octopuses and squid, have mantles that do not form into shells.
- Shells can come in one solid piece, like snails and conchs. There are also shells that come in two halves that close together, called bivalves, like oysters and clams.
- Because there are so many types and species of mollusk, they can be found in both fresh water and salt water. They can even be found on land- snails and slugs love our gardens in and out of the sea!
- Many types of mollusks have a muscle called a foot. This foot is not just for walking. Some mollusks use their foot for digging, crawling, or even catching prey.
- Some mollusks have an organ called a radula, which is like a tongue covered in tiny teeth. The radula is used to scrape food from surfaces. A radula can have as many as a quarter million teeth!

Guppy Goodies



Snails and Caterpillars

Ingredients

- Celery stalks
- Peanut butter or cream cheese, at room temperature
- Sliced fruit and vegetables- apple, orange, kiwi, cucumber, tomato
- Grapes
- Blueberries
- Grape tomatoes
- Celery or radish matchsticks
- Cashews
- Candy eyes

Instructions

Snails:

Fill celery stalks with peanut butter or cream cheese and top with an apple orange, kiwi, cucumber, or tomato slice shell. Add a cashew for the head. Use peanut butter or cream cheese to glue on the candy eyes.

Caterpillars:

Fill celery stalks with peanut butter or cream cheese and top with grapes, blueberries, or grape tomatoes for the body and head. Use peanut butter or cream cheese to glue on the candy eyes and celery or radish matchsticks for antennae.
