






- Skates and rays are in a group of fish called elasmobranchs. Elasmobranchs have skeletons made of cartilage and have five gill slits on each side of their head. This group includes skates, rays, sawfish, and sharks.
- There are approximately 630 species of skates and rays that are divided into 18 different families.
- One main difference between rays and skates is that rays have live births while skates lay eggs. Skate eggs are in hard cases called mermaid purses!
- Not all rays are stingrays. Some rays, like manta rays, have long, barbless tails. Other rays, like the spotted eagle ray, have venomous spines on their tails.
- The oceanic manta ray is the largest ray species in the world. From wing tip to wing tip, they can grow to at least 23 feet and weigh up to an impressive 4,000 pounds!
- The electric ray has two kidney- shaped electric organs located on its back, can produce between 8 to 220 volts of electricity.
- The shark ray is also known as the bowmouth guitarfish because of it having a guitar- shaped body.
- The big skate can be found from Baja
 California all the way into Alaska. It is also
 one of the largest species of skates and can
 reach 8 feet in length and 200 pounds!
- When baby manta rays are born, they look like a rolled- up burrito!
