


- Alligators are semi- aquatic animals, spending time both in water and on land.
 During their time in water, alligators can hold their breath for 45 minutes.
- Alligators are reptiles, which means they are cold- blooded, have a backbone, and they are covered in scales.
- Alligators are massive. They can weigh over 800 pounds and grow up to 13 feet long.
- The largest alligator on record was found in 1890 in Louisiana. It measured 19 feet 2 inches long and weighed nearly 2000 pounds!
- There are two types of alligators: the American alligator and the Chinese alligator. American alligators can be found in the freshwater areas of the southern United States from North Carolina to Texas.
- The average alligator goes through 2000 to 3000 teeth in its lifetime.
- Alligators have not evolved much since the dinosaur ages.
- Alligators are fast runners. They have the ability to run at least 35 miles per hour.
- An alligator has very little strength for opening their mouth, but the muscles that shut it are very strong.
