It is February, the shortest month of the year, the month of love - and hopefully melting snow! :) It is nice to see the longer days - Spring is for sure on it's way!

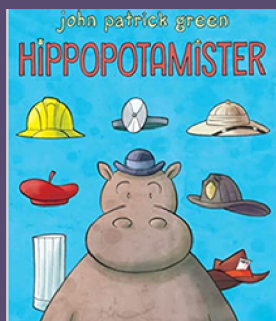

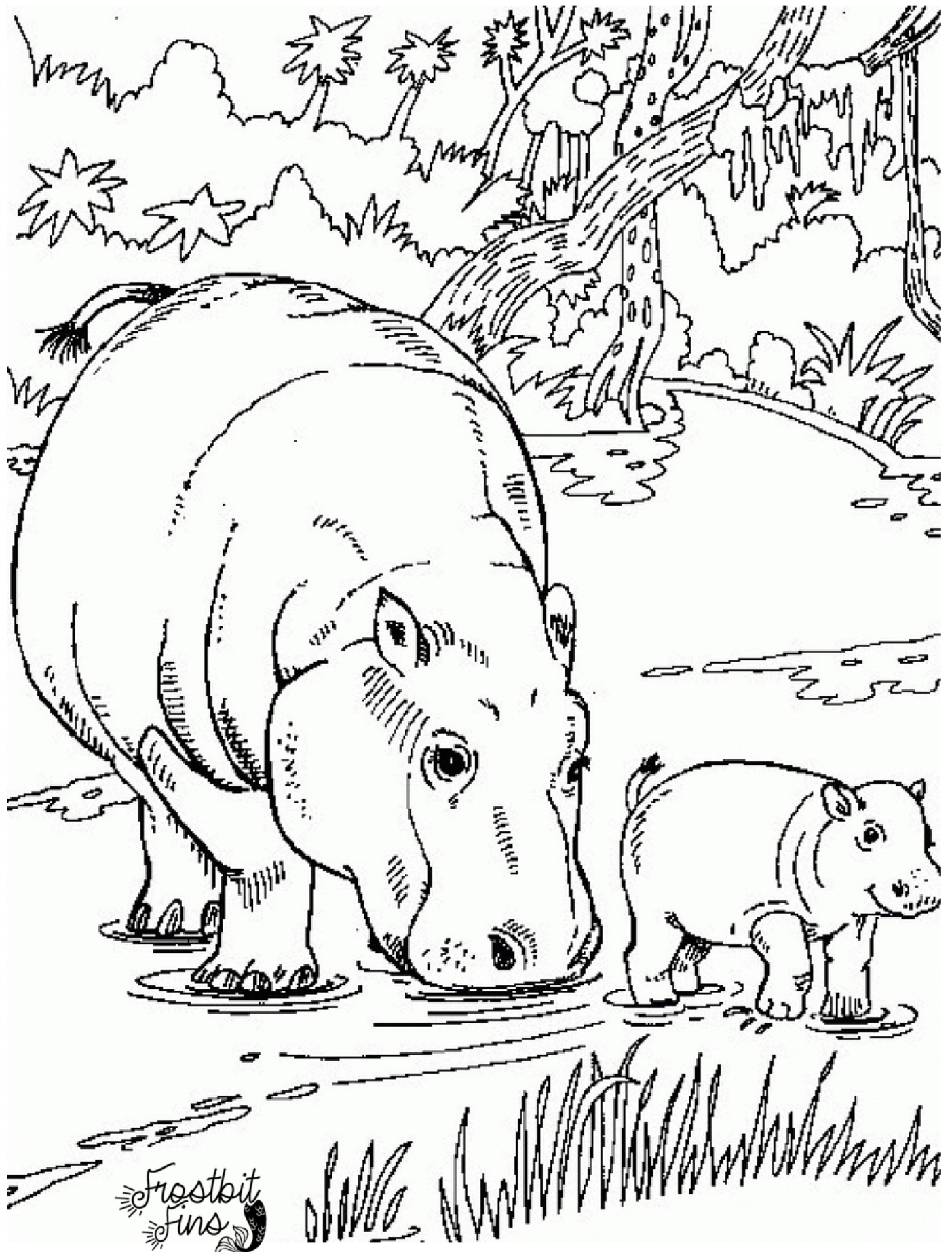
FEBRUARY FIN FACTS WITH



HIPPOPOTAMUS



- Hippos are semi-aquatic mammals, living both in water and on land.
- Hippos are the third largest animal on land. Coming in behind elephants and the white rhinoceros a male hippo can measure 17 feet long, 5 feet tall, and can weigh over 9,000 pounds!
- To protect their skin hippos sweat an oily red liquid that prevents it from drying out. Their sweat also acts as sunblock.
- A hippo's eyes, nose, and ears are all located on top of their head. This allows the hippo to be able to see, hear, and breathe while being mostly submerged in the water. When they do completely submerge their ears and nostrils fold shut to keep the water out.
- Hippos are herbivores. While they eat different plants, they mostly consume grasses. A hippo can eat up to 70 pounds of grass a day!
- Hippos live in groups called bloats. Bloats are led by one larger male and have 10-40 members.
- A hippo's vocal call is called a wheeze honk.
- The word 'hippopotamus' comes from ancient Greek words meaning 'river horse'.
- The largest canine teeth on a hippo are called tusks. Hippo tusks are made up of ivory.
- Hippos cannot swim. They sink and float by controlling their breathing and body position, then stand and walk along the bottom of the river/ lake.
- Hippos live in and along rivers, lakes, swamps, and mangroves throughout sub-Saharan Africa.
- There are only two species in the hippopotamidae family- the common river hippo and the pygmy hippo.

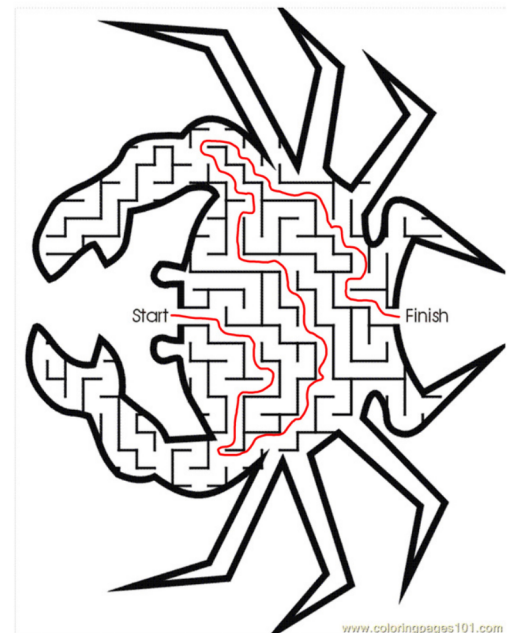
