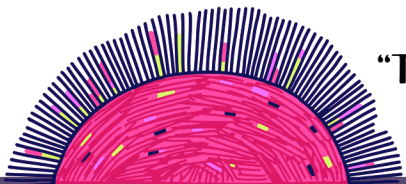
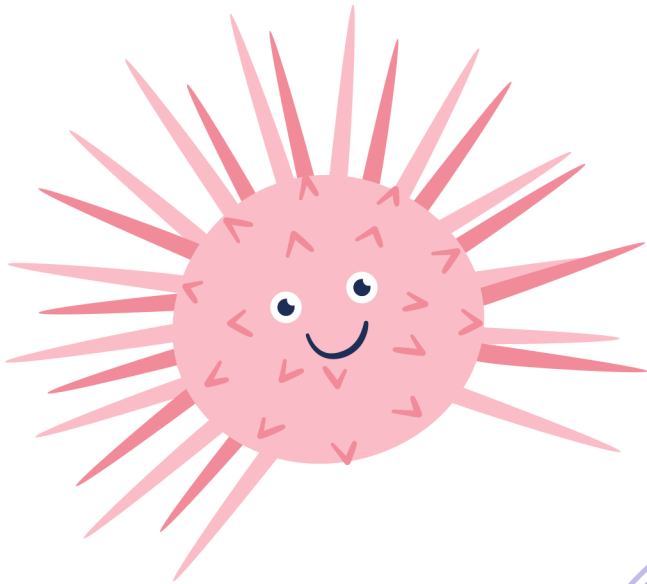

a Message from the Mermaid and the FrostbitFins Pod

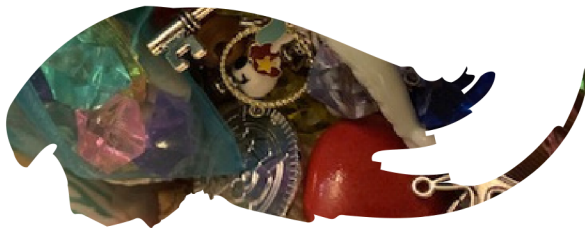
Anyone see where March went? I swear it was right here just a moment ago...

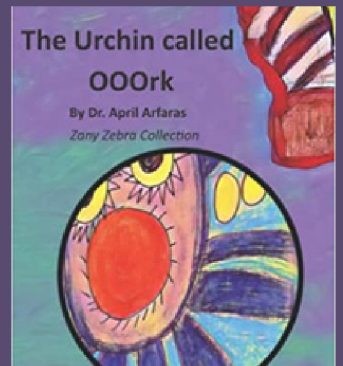
So - until next time - we are sending you mermaid wishes and starfish kisses!

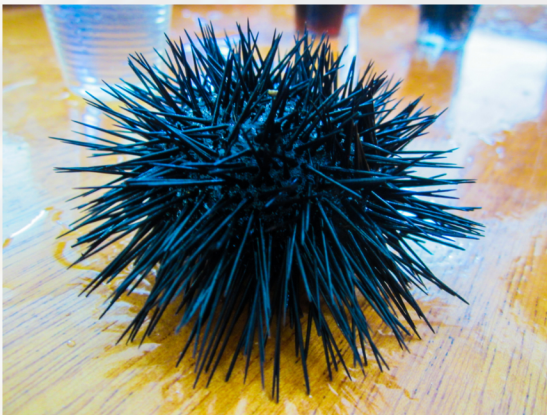
APRIL FIN FACTS WITH **SEA URCHINS**



- Sea urchins are members of the scientific group Echinodermata, meaning “spiny skinned”.
- The long, movable spines that cover the sea urchins body work with their tube like feet to help them to “walk”. They are also used to keep predators away.



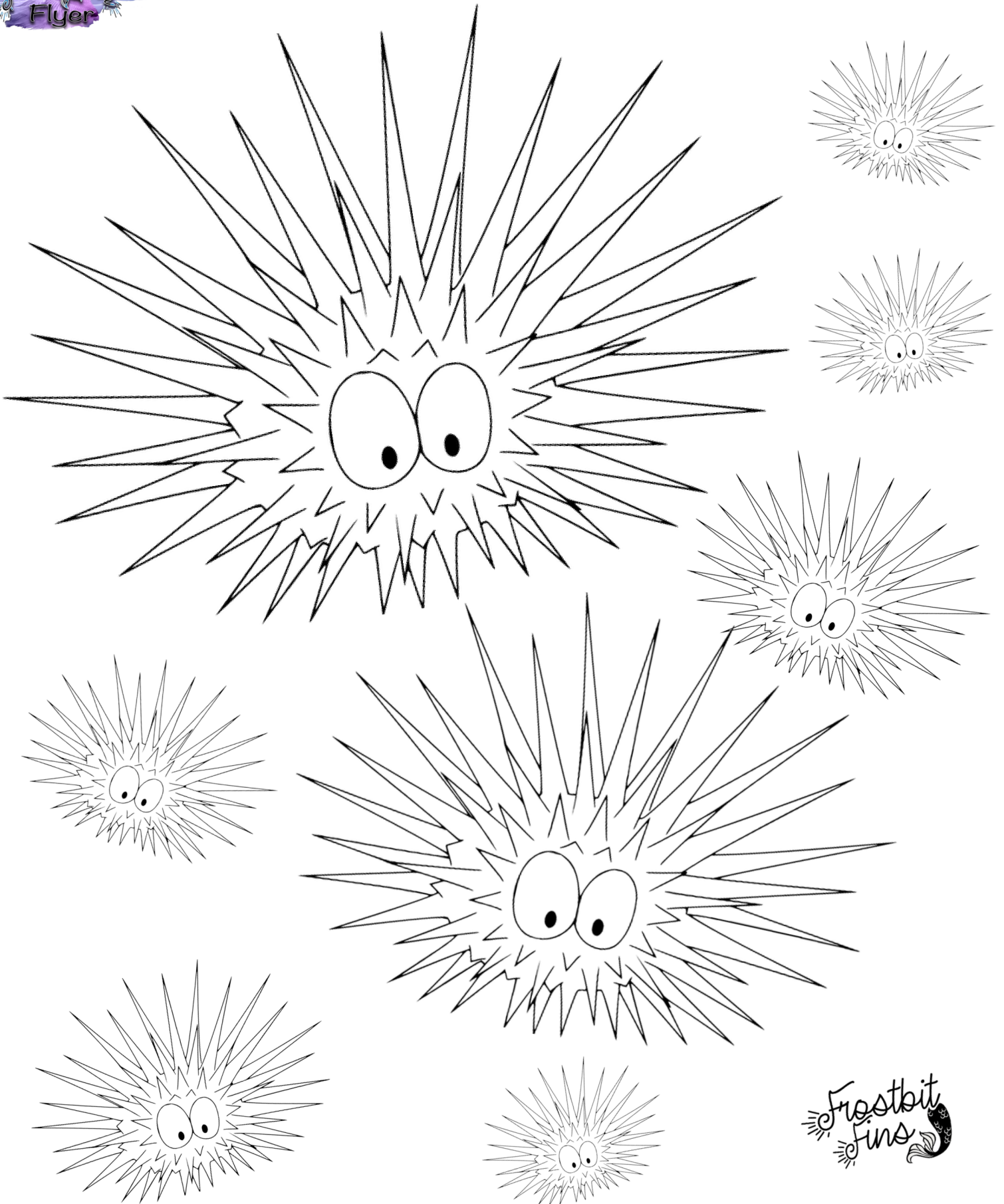
- There are more than 900 species of sea urchins.
- The mouth of sea urchins, called Aristotle’s lantern, has five jaws that have one tooth each. Some urchins have teeth so strong that they can drill holes in coral, rock, or even steel!

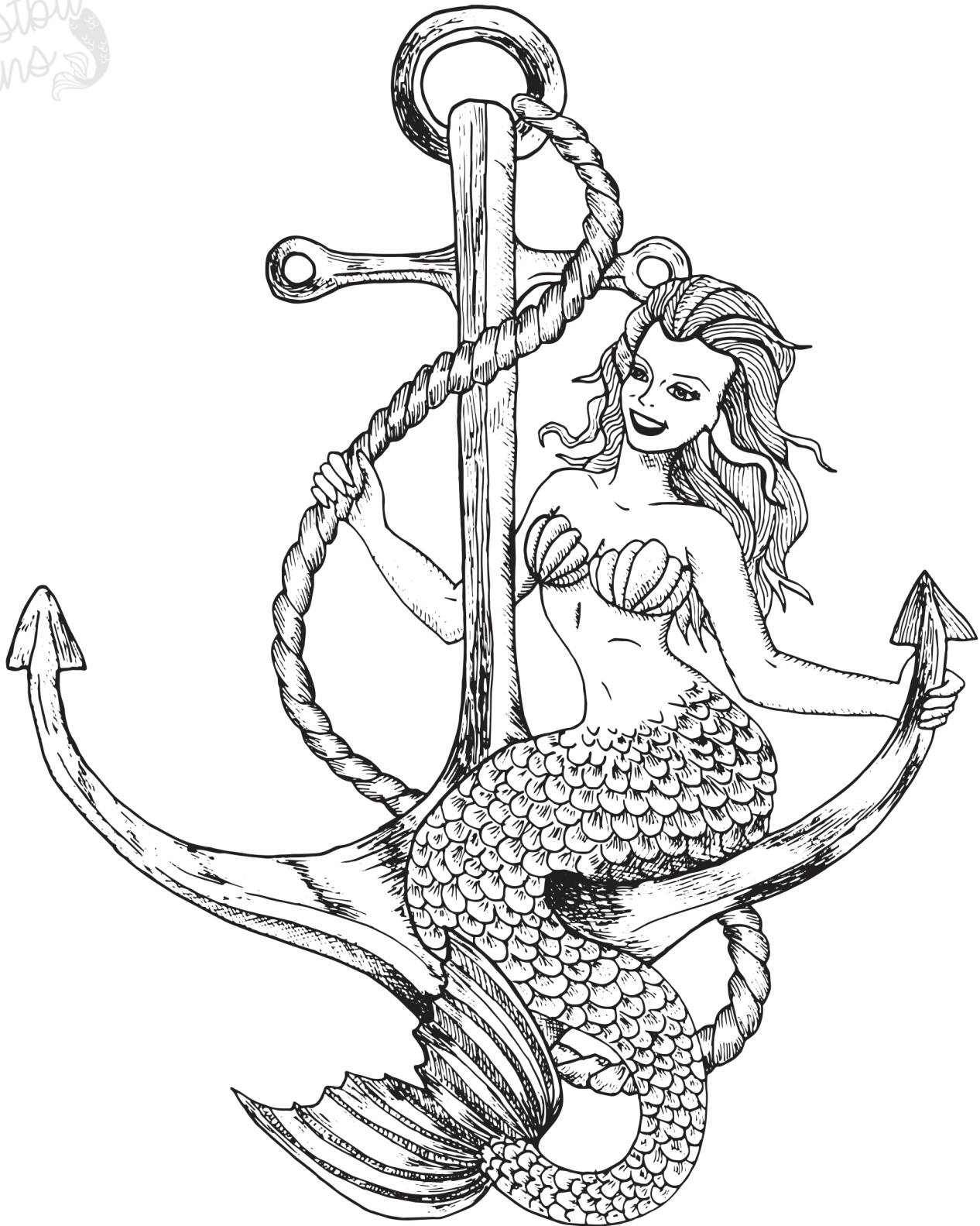


- Sea urchins can live up to 200 years old!
- Sea urchins are called that because hedgehogs used to be called urchins. Since they share a spiny appearance, sea urchins are also called sea hedgehogs.



- Sea lilies, sea cucumbers, sand dollars, and sea stars are all closely related to sea urchins.
- The size of sea urchins vary greatly. Their bodies can measure less than 1 inch side to side all the way up to 14 inches side to side. The spine of some sea urchins can grow up to 12 inches long!





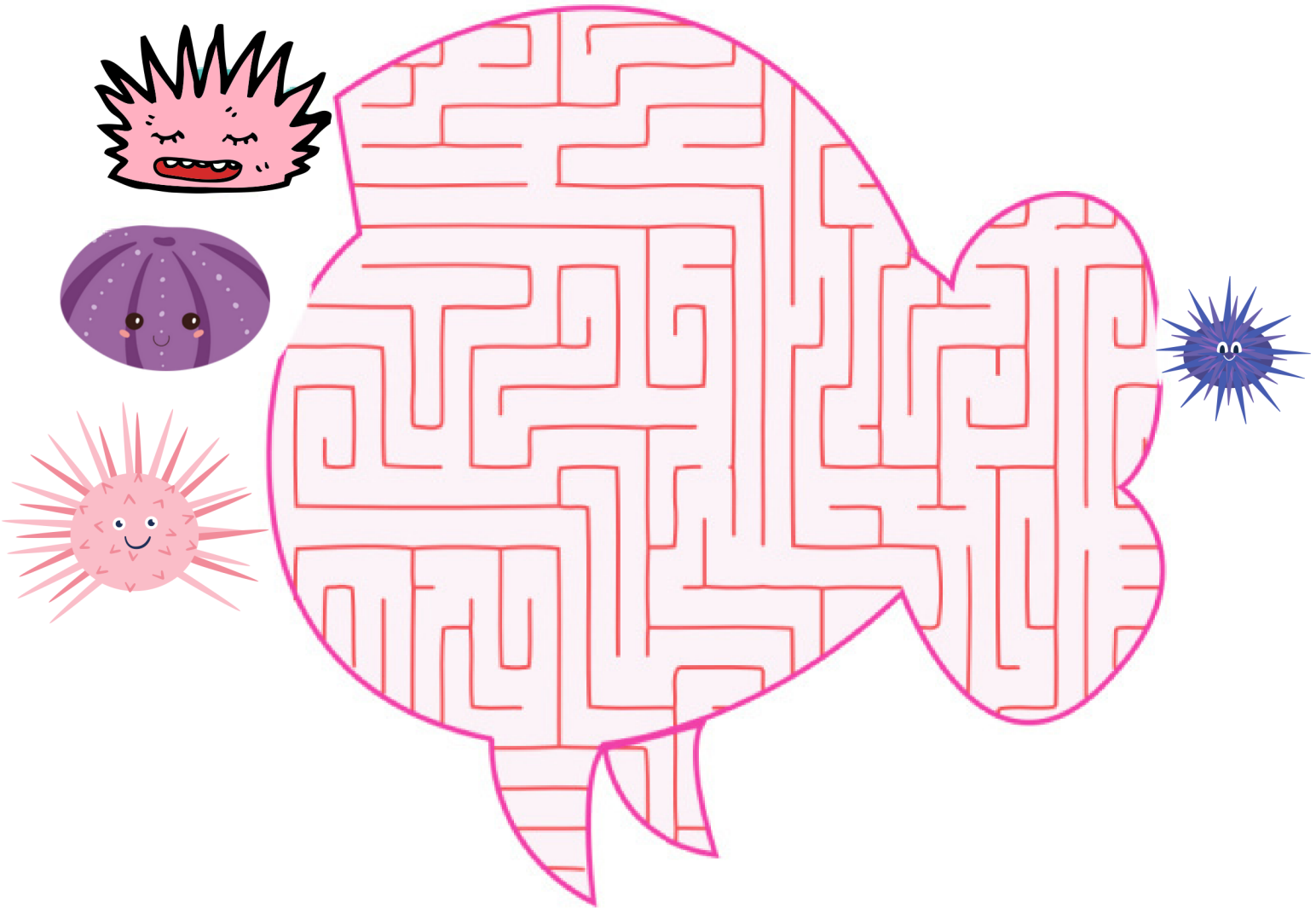

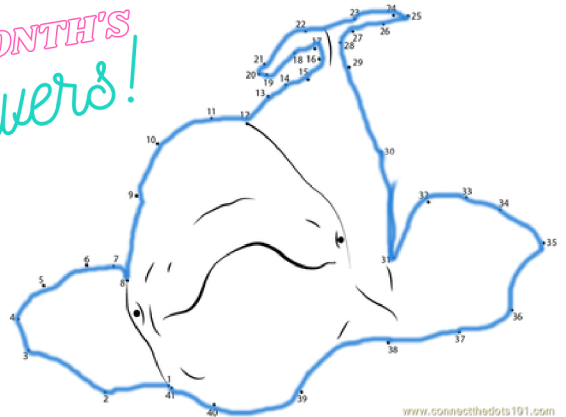


SEA URCHIN MAZE

SEA URCHIN COOKIES

Ingredients:

- 11- ounce package chocolate chips
- 6- ounce package chow mein noodles

Directions:

- Pour chow mein noodles into a bowl.
- In a separate bowl, melt chocolate chips in the microwave 30 seconds at a time, stirring in between.
