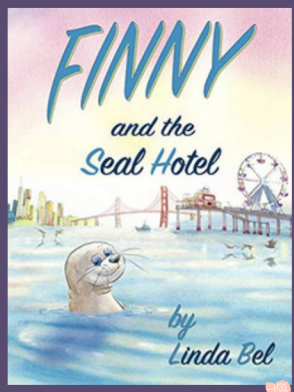

AUGUST FIN FACTS WITH



SEALS!



- Seals range in size from 3 feet long and 100 pounds for the earless Baikal seal, up to 16 feet long and 7,100 pounds for the elephant seal.

- Some species of seals can hold their breath for nearly 2 hours underwater by slowing their heartbeat and conserving oxygen.

- There are around 33 species of seals.

- Seals have a layer of fat under their skin called blubber, which keeps them warm in cold water. They also have a slick fur coat that is streamlined for gliding through water.

- Seal whiskers are very sensitive. They can detect vibrations in the water, helping them to hunt in the dark and murky sea.

- Seals are big eaters. They grey seal can eat up to 10 pounds of food in a single day!

- Baby seals, called pups, are unable to start hunting until they are about a month old, when their fur develops enough for them to glide through the water. They still stick close to their mothers until they are fully grown at eight years old.

- Seals prefer cold sea waters, primarily in the Arctic and Antarctic regions.

- In Antarctica, where colonies of elephant seals aggregate, their poop enriches the soil and supports communities of lichens.

- There are seven species of seals found in Alaska: Bearded, Ringed, Spotted, Ribbon, Harbor, Northern Elephant and Northern Fur.

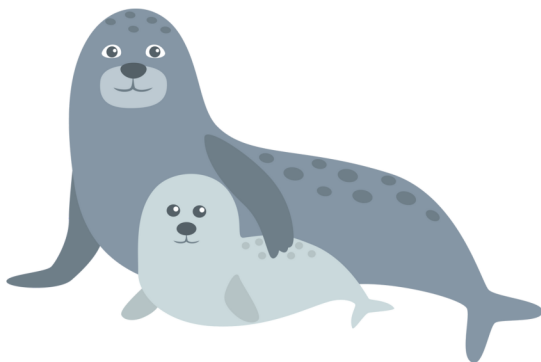
Seal Snacks

Ingredients

- 1 green apple
- A few black grapes
- 6 slivered almonds
- (Parental Supervision required for slicing!)

Directions

- Using your knife, slice 1 round piece off your apple and place it on a plate. Slice off 1 more round piece and slice that piece into quarters. You will use 2 of these quarters for the seal's flippers.
- Slice 1 black grape in half and place each half on the seal for the eyes. Slice another black grape in half and place on the seal for the nose. Next, slice 2 very thin slices off your remaining grape and place on the seal for the mouth.
- Finally, take 6 slivered almonds and place 3 on each side for the seal's whiskers.
