We have some exciting ideas that we're working on for the next season too and hope to have a sneak peak soon - so stay tuned for that.

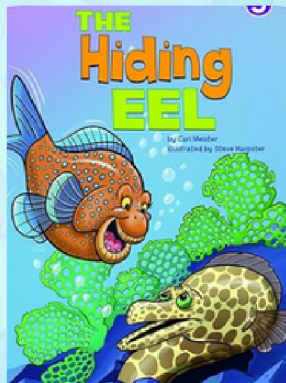

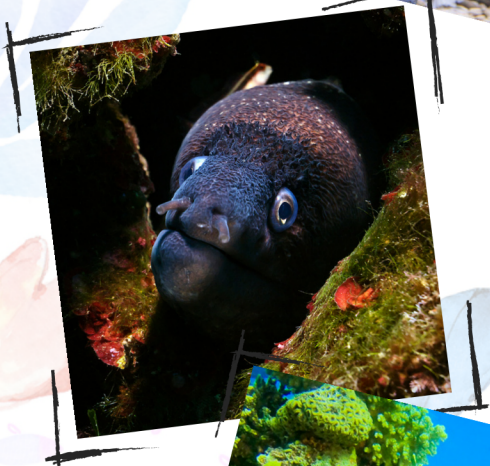

# January Fin Facts

## Eels!

- There are over 800 species of eels scattered throughout the waters of the world.
- The lives of all European and American eels start and end at the Sargasso Sea. In the last year of its life the eel moves toward the Sargasso to breed and die.
- Eels cannot produce electricity. What we know as the electric eel is not a true eel. It is actually a knife fish.
- Since eels do not have caudal fins to help propel themselves, eels move through the water by moving their bodies like a rolling wave. They are able to swim backwards by reversing the direction of that wave.
- Eels start life in larvae form. After that they move into a stage called glass eel. During the glass eel stage they are flat and transparent. This makes it very difficult for them to be tracked.
- The moray eel belongs to the Muraenidae family. They are long and slender and are found in warm and temperate waters. They can grow up to 13 feet long. Some species of moray include snowflake, zebra, honeycomb, and turkey.
- The conger eel belongs to the congridae family. They are long and slender as well, but have a more rounded body shape compared to the moray and only grow up to 10 feet long. They are found in temperate, but cooler waters. Some species of conger include European, longfin African, manytooth, and beach.
- There are many other families and species of eels including the purple spaghetti eel, the duckbill oceanic eel, the pelican eel, the New Zealand longfin eel, the zig-zag eel, and many, many others.
